

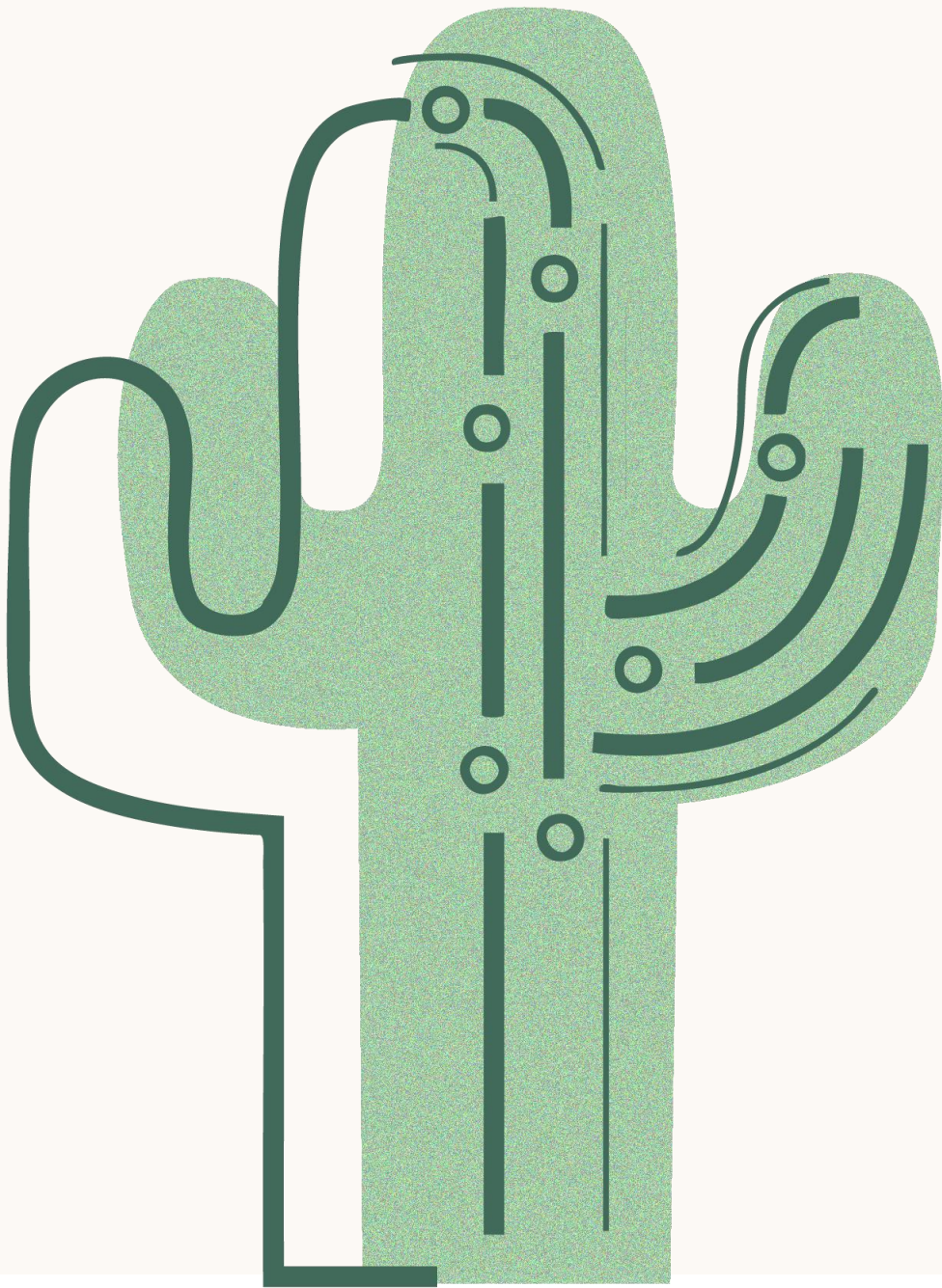

1. Purpose

These General Terms and Conditions of Use (the "GTCU") set out the rules governing access to and use of the Digital Cactus website, available at : <https://digital-cactus.eu/>

The Website forms part of the European project "Digital CARE Contribution to the Transformation of User Services" (hereinafter referred to as "Digital Cactus"). It provides information about the project and presents the activities carried out within its framework. These GTCU define the rights and obligations of any user when accessing and using the Digital Cactus platform, as well as the applicable legal and regulatory provisions. Is considered a "User" within the meaning of these GTCU any person who accesses the Website.

The Digital Cactus project is led by a consortium of five partners: University Paris Cité, Leiden University Medical Center, University Hospital of North Norway, University of Glasgow, and North Estonia Medical Centre.

The ultimate objective is to provide European health authorities with a practical, evidence-based resource to support the effective integration of digital technologies into national care pathways and to ensure they benefit the patients who need them most.

The Website Owner reserves the right to modify or update the content at any time without prior notice. The Website Owner has the right to remove any illegal or otherwise forbidden (copyrighted, immoral etc) content either indefinitely or until the content has been modified to be in accordance with the T&C.



5. Intellectual Property

Any total or partial representation or exploitation of all or part of the elements of the Website by any person (natural or legal entity) whatsoever, without the express authorization of the Website Owner and the Director of Publication, is strictly prohibited and shall constitute an act of infringement.

6. User obligation and Liability

The User undertakes to use the Website strictly in accordance with the purpose defined in these GTCU and in compliance with applicable laws and regulations, and to provide only information and content that are necessary for contact purposes when filling the contact form. The User further undertakes not to disrupt the normal operation of the Website. Any failure to comply with these obligations may give rise to legal proceedings.

The disclosure of certain illegal content (e.g. photographs, videos, comments) by the User in connection with the use of the Website may result in criminal and civil liability. As such, the User indemnifies the Website Owner against any administrative, criminal or civil proceedings, and any out-of-court disputes based on such exchanges of content initiated by the User, even partially.
